## Distance of Trails

### Multi-use Nonmotorized Trails

Heritage Trail -- 1.0 km  
Kiddie Loop ---- 1.8 km  
Orange Loop ---- 2.2 km  
Red Loop ----- 2.6 km  
Blue Loop ----- 3.3 km  
Green A ----- 14 km  
Green B ----- 10 km  
Green C ----- 5.5 km  
Elderberry Loop -- 3 km  
Dragonfly Loop - 4.2 km  
Stonewall Trail - 1.9 km

### Multi-use Motorized Trails

Luna Trail ----- 3.0 km  
Fisher Trail ----- 2.3 km  
Flying Squirrel - 1.8 km



## All Users

- Please respect all other Forest users
- Please avoid wet trails as use will cause damage

## Dogs

- Dogs must be under control at all times
- Unleashed dogs can cause:
  - spooked horses which are dangerous for the dog, rider and other trail users,
  - dangerous encounters with other dogs and wildlife (e.g., porcupines, bears),
  - disturbance to wildlife,
  - increased dog waste on trails

## Cyclists

- Please call out as early as possible to notify other users of your presence.
- When meeting horseback riders, please stop immediately and ask the rider how to proceed. A spooked horse can be dangerous. Talk to the horse and rider in a calm voice and remove sunglasses and helmet to let the horse know you are a person.

## Horseback Riders

- Please clean up after your horse in parking lot, trailhead areas and along trail.
- Please do not use the Green trail section along Hogsback Hill. Follow bypass signage.
